## Principal Church Reports Deerfield School Honor Roll

## Matthew Glassett Wins Evergreen Geography Bee

SCOTCH PLAINS - Matthew Glassett, a fourth grader at Evergreen Elementary School in Scotch Plains, was the school-level winner of the National Geographic Bee, which was held recently at the school.

The school-level competition, during which students answered oral geography questions at a student assembly, was the first round in the 14th annual National Geographic Bee.

By winning at the school level, Matthew earned the opportunity to advance in the Bee and possibly attain a \$25,000 college scholarship.

All fourth and fifth grade students at Evergreen School participated in the contest by answering several rounds of multiple choice and other types of questions.

The top five fifth and fourth grade scorers then competed in the school finals, which were conducted by

Evergreen School Principal Randy De Brito. Runner-up in the finals was fifth grader Cody Kalebota.

Matthew and all other school winners in New Jersey will now take a written multiple choice test that is scored by the National Geographic Society.

The top 100 scorers in each state and territory will be eligible to compete in their state Bees in April. State champions will receive all-expense paid trips to Washington, D.C. in May when they will vie for the national title in the televised finals of the Bee, moderated by "Jeopardy" host, Alex Trebek.

The National Geographic Society, the world's largest non-profit scientific and educational organization, supports this educational program as one way to combat geographic illiteracy.
