## Burgdorff ERA Hosts Charity Event Benefiting NJ's Children

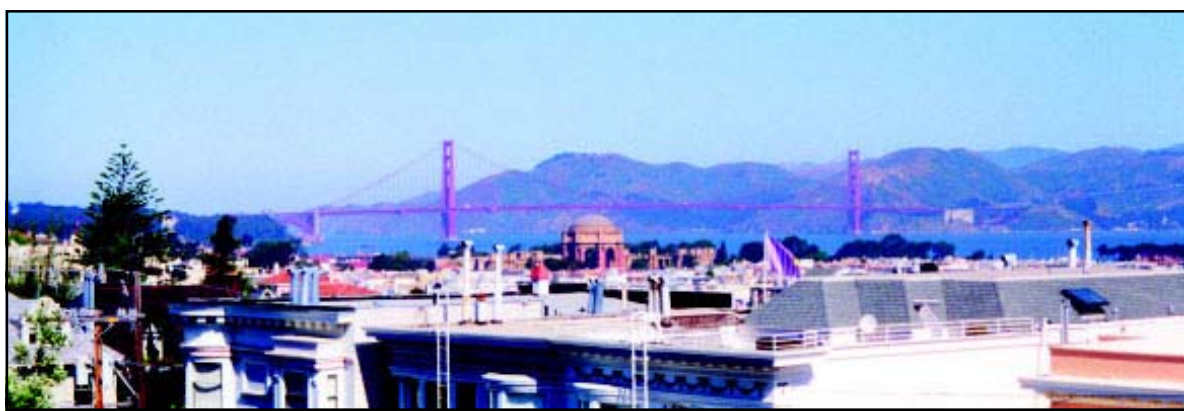
