Summer Program: The Fanwood Recreation commission will conduct a seven-week summer program for Fanwood Children at LaGrande Park. The program will begin on Thursday June 24 and will end on Friday August 6.

The programs are under the direction of Mr. Kevin Ewing, Executive Director and Mr. Tom Baylock, Assistant Director. The program runs Monday through Friday, June 24 to August 6, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. weather permitting. The parks will close due to rain or extreme heat. The park will be closed on Monday, July 5.

Summer Activities: Activities include Crafts, Tournaments, Games, Sports and Special events. Age groups: 5 to 7 and 8 years and up. Each week will have different events. Each week there will be a different theme.
