

## Westfield's Lauren Ross Sets New Jersey Swim Record

At the Winterfest Swim Meet held at the Sonny Werblin Recreation Center at Rutgers University on January 8-9, Lauren Ross of Westfield broke the New Jersey swimming record for girls 11-12 group in the 1,000-yard freestyle with a time of at 10:48.85, which is currently the ninth fastest time this season for 11-12 girls across the nation.

It is a National Reportable Time (NRT), which may give Lauren recognition as one of the Top 16 in the nation as ranked by USA Swimming. The rankings are compiled annually at the close of the summer season in August.

Lauren, a seventh grader at Roosevelt Intermediate School, is in her second year competing for Ber-

keley Aquatic Club under the direction of Head Coach Jim Wood. She set the record just eight days before her 13th birthday.

In her first meet as a 13-year-old, the Junior/Senior State Meet held at Seton Hall University on February 18-20, Lauren dominated the distance freestyle events, winning all three races: the 500-yard free in 5:16.44; the 1,000-yard free in 10:51.02; and the 1,650-yard free in 18:20.10.
