WESTFIELD - The Westfield Board of Education formally thanked more than a dozen Westfield citizens in February for their part in helping communicate the district's bond proposal to the community.

At a reception held in the Student Center of Westfield High School, Anne Riegel, BOE president, and Ann Cary, board chairperson of the Community Outreach Ad Hoc Committee, presented certificates of appreciation to the volunteers who formed the Citizens for Education, the bond steering committee, back in October 2006. The bond referendum successfully passed at an election held January 23.

"Through your grassroots effort, we had a record voter turnout of 25 percent of all voters," Mrs. Riegel said to volunteers and their family members.

She commended them for "helping the community understand the importance of opening space at all of our elementary schools and renovat-

ing our aging facilities. "Passing this bond referendum was truly a matter of one neighbor talking to another - answering questions, addressing concerns and spreading the word."

Mrs. Riegel added, "The Citizens for Education, chaired by Linda Habgood, brainstormed ways to effectively reach out and educate the community about the value of establishing Lincoln School as an Early Childhood Learning Center and of renovating Roosevelt Intermediate School, our oldest facility, and continuing to replace the windows at Edison Intermediate School."

Mrs. Riegel also thanked the Westfield Parent Teacher Council and the PTO's for their input and their help and the Westfield Education Association for its support.
