Proposed is 1 person other than a household family member employed in a home occupation. \$12.04F1 allows a maximum building coverage of 20%. Proposed is ±21.7%. \$11.08E13 allows a maximum continuous side wall length of 25 feet. Proposed is ± 28.5 feet.
