Summer Reading Clubs Are Open to All Ages at Library

WESTFIELD – The Westfield Memorial Library, located at 550 East Broad Street, is offering reading clubs for all ages this summer. "Between the Pages" is for adults 18 and over; "Own the Night" is for teens entering grades 6 to 12; "Dream Big: Read" is for pre-school through grade 6, and the Little Listeners "Dream Big: Read" program is for children who are not yet reading on their own.

"Between the Pages," the second annual adult summer reading club, will run from Monday, June 25, to Saturday, August 25. Participants must be full-service Westfield Memorial Library cardholders. Individuals will check out an item from the library and fill out an entry form to win prizes. One entry form will be allowed per checkout, but entry forms will be limited to one checkout per day.

Weekly random drawings will be held for prizes donated by local businesses. Grand prizes donated by 16 Prospect Bistro and Wine Bar and Acquaviva delle Fonti will be awarded at the end of July and August. The "Westfield Reads" blogspot, wmlra.blogspot.com, has suggestions for book titles and will list winners each week.

"Dream Big: Read" is designed to include children of all ages and reading abilities and features prizes and recommended booklists for each grade from preschool through sixth grade. Registration for "Dream Big" currently is underway for full-service Westfield Memorial Library cardholders and will continue through August 25. The Little Listeners Club,

"Own the Night" is an online Summer Reading Program designed specifically for teens. The club is underway and will take place through August 25. Any teen entering grades 6 to 12 who are full-service library cardholders can join the club via the Internet.

Prizes include a free, one-night rental from the library's DVD collection, a \$5 gift card from Cold Stone Creamery or Starbucks, and a new hardcover book.
