

## Raider 12s Top WF Blue in Ripken District

single, an RBI and a walk. "We had some great starting pitching from Reyes. He also hit a big home run early in the game and he almost had another one in centerfield. It would have been, but we moved the centerfield fence back to 250 feet this year. The other day we had a home run from Matt Manning," Westfield Blue Head Coach Dan Eliades said. Westfield Blue leadoff hitter Corey Billings stirred up plenty of action with a single, two walks, two stolen bases and two runs scored. Chris Marner (run scored) and Mark Shiamo (2 stolen bases, walk) both singled. Tanner Devin and Graham Studwell both walked twice and stole bases. Andrew Eliades walked once, while Cory Hiltz, Brett Deanna and Matt Bromberg added plate appearances. Raider Downey led off the top of the first inning with a walk and stole two bases. Lipshitz stepped to the plate and brought him home with a grounder to third. Westfield Blue

immediately answered with two runs. Billings walked, stole second and dashed to third on a passed ball. Manning added an RBI grounder to second then Reyes hammered his solo shot over the leftfield fence. Westfield Blue increased their lead to 3-1 in the second but not without a pair of wild plays on the bases. Devin walked, stole second and moved to third on Marner's looping single over first base. When Marner moved to steal second, Raider catcher Kriney fired a cutoff throw to Schetelich at short, who fired home to nail Devin at the plate. In the meantime, Marner scooted to third and later scored on Billings' squibbling infield single. Billings stole second and third then Eliades drew a walk but continued to race to second to draw a throw, which would give Billings a chance to score. Instead Raider pitcher McCormack fired to third to catch Billings in a rundown for the third out. The Raiders put together four runs

on four hits, highlighted by Dinizo's two-run double, Lipshitz's RBI single and Schetelich's RBI grounder to take a 5-3 lead in the third. Schetelich then turned a second-to-first double play in the bottom of the inning to halt Westfield Blue. In the fifth, Dinizo drew a one-out walk and sprinted to second on a grounder, but he returned to first when he misinterpreted the call as a foul ball. He was tagged out. Westfield Blue answered with a run when Reyes launched his long RBI sac fly to center. The Raiders added two runs in the sixth. McCormack singled and scored on Leegan's single to right. After Mooney's sacrifice bunt moved Leegan from second to third, Downey tapped a slow roller to third, allowing him to score. "There were some interesting plays out there. Some you win. Some you lose," Coach Eliades said. "When we play Westfield, it's always going to be a challenge. There were a lot of weird plays. Both teams played hard," Coach Higgins said.
