Committee Seeks Support For Historic Home Move

MOUNTAINSIDE - A historic property on the corner of New Providence Road and Mountain Avenue in Mountainside, the address of which is 2 New Providence Road, has been sold. The seller and buyer have agreed to allow the Mountainside Restoration Committee to take possession of the landmark structure located on the property and save it by moving it to a secure location.

This circa 1818 structure, which was most recently the home of Patterson Interiors preceded by Barrett and Crain Realtors, was originally on property owned by the Miller and Cory families, who were prominent members of the "Westfields" of Elizabethtown and Mountainside communities.

Levi Cory once owned the house and rented it, in 1892, to the founders of the "Children's Country Home" as a summer retreat for inner city children. This was the beginning of what is now Children's Specialized Hospital.

Because of its significance in the history of the Mountainside/Westfield area, the Mountainside Restoration Committee has proposed to move the house and save it from destruction. The Borough of Mountainside has allowed the committee to use borough-owned property located on Constitution Plaza between the Mountainside Fire Department and Mountainside Public Library to situate the Levi Cory house. This will place it appropriately next door to the historic Deacon Andrew Hetfield House.

The Mountainside Restoration Committee is relying on fundraising to support the move of the Levi Cory house and the site preparation required to permanently place it on Constitution Plaza. Anyone interested in helping to fund this move is asked

Home Video Studio, Student Team to Help Chinese Orphans

WESTFIELD - Growing up at a Chinese orphanage is not an easy life. Westfield sixth grader Eliza Weiniger was fortunate to be adopted from one, just shy of her first birthday. "I spent the first year of my life in a Chinese orphanage before I was adopted and found my family," she said. "Thousands of other children will not be as fortunate."

Now 12 years old and preparing for her Bat Mitzvah, Eliza chose to raise money for Chinese orphanages through the organization Love Without Boundaries Orphanage Assistance Program. The organization provides basic living supplies to children in Chinese orphanages, like safe cribs, blankets, diapers, formula, clean water, incubators, playground equipment, heating and cooling systems and more.

"I'm trying to raise money to change the life of these children who must grow up without the love of a family," said Eliza.

A Bar or Bat Mitzvah is a Jewish coming-of-age ceremony where a child turns 13 and accepts the responsibilities of Jewish adulthood. It's common to do a Mitzvah project,

a social service project during the Bar and Bat Mitzvah preparation, which allows the child to make a difference by raising awareness, funds or supplies for an organization or cause in need. Eliza is a member of Westfield's Temple Emanu-El.
