nearly got into the act as he was sprinting up the center between Dedeia and Prosus.

"He didn't but almost. I just got it past him and it went straight to Mike," Dedeia said.

The Cougars averted the shut-out when junior forward Mark Christiano curled a looping shot

into the net. with 9:30 remaining in the game. With 2:30 remaining, Blue Devil forward Jackson Dumont drew Meliado out of position and tapped the ball into the unguarded net.
