Westfield Post Office Offers Holiday Mailing Advice

WESTFIELD - Westfield Postmaster Kenneth Brown has suggested that using priority or express mail can make mailing holiday packages simpler.

Postmaster Brown noted that priority mail allows packages weighing up to two pounds to be sent anywhere in the country for \$3. Larger packages weighing up to five pounds may be sent for as low as \$6.

Priority mail is normally delivered in two or three days, and merchandise insurance is available for an additional fee.

Since winter weather conditions can close airports and halt highway

transportation, the United States Postal Service has advised that parcels mailed after Sunday, December 20, be sent by express mail to ensure delivery by Christmas.

Express mail items will be delivered overnight to most major United States cities. The cost for packages weighing up to half a pound is \$10.75, and \$15 for packages up to two pounds.

Express mail includes \$500 insurance and there is no additional fee for delivery on Christmas Day.

The Post Office will provide free priority and express mail cardboard boxes, envelopes, and mailing labels.
