Sophomore Jeff Hensel is expected to start at second and junior Steve Williams will also see time at second then play center when Maroney is pitching. Junior Josh Finklestein will be the primary shortstop.

"We will be moving people around there," pointed out Homm of the shortstop position.

Junior Brian Schiller and sophomores Kyle Adams and Josh Wexler will share time in right field.

On the positive side, team speed is up somewhat and that could translate to base stealing.

"Baumwoll, Blasi, Williams and Adams have good speed and so does Maroney," said Homm.

The Raiders opened with rivals Westfield on April 2 and won 7-2 behind the strong pitching of Maroney, who tossed a complete game.

DiDario commented, "I would like to break the 220 barrier for the half

mile mark and score very highly in the group meet, hoping the team can get a group and county title."

The Highlanders boast a fabulous crop of freshman which include Arda Hotz, Jen Hauser, Kait Anders, Kristen Midbo, Elise Hubert and Kelly Jimines.
