January 24, 2014: Team depth paid off, especially in both freestyle relays, for the Westfield High School boys swim team that overcame a 32-30 deficit after four events to pull away from 6-1 Bergen Catholic (BC) en route to a 93-77 victory at Wallace Pool in Westfield on January 24. John Lindros, swimming in Lane 6, led a 1-2-3 sweep in the 200-free when he tapped the wall at 1:46.56, followed by Aedan Collins and Alec Penn. Lindros also won the 500-free and was also on both winning relays.

Blue Devils not only remained undefeated, but the seniors have never lost a meet, which included three victories in a row over IHA. Seniors Caroline Baldwin and Sarah Cronin each won two individual events and swam on two winning relays, while Gwyn Devin won an individual event and swam on two winning relays, and Erika Daniel won an individual event and swam on a winning relay.

January 22, 2012: Persistence overcame resistance twice for Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School senior Sean Cannon, who battled his way through a very tough semifinal bout and an even tougher final bout to grab the 152-lb wrestling crown and the Outstanding Wrestler Award (upper weights) at the Union County Tournament (UCT) in Union on January 22. Blue Devil Head Coach Glen Kurz was named Union County Coach of the Year.

Blue Devil senior Mike Kalimtzis reached the 120-lb finals to face GL's Ryan Morrison (UCT 112-lb champ

in 2011). Kalimtzis recorded a low double-leg takedown in the first period and controlled Morrison from the top position the entire second period to earn a 2-1 victory. Raider heavyweight Anthony Tufaro defeated Mike Christian (Brearley), 3-0, for the UCT crown. Raider senior Andrew Jacobs pinned Cougar Jeff Weiss in 5:19 to claim the 220-lb title.

January 21, 2010: Little or no mistakes could be made if the Westfield High School boys basketball team wanted to knock off No. 5 Plainfield in Westfield on January 21. The 6-5 Blue Devils made few mistakes to dominate the first quarter, 14-9, but passing inconsistency allowed the 11-0 Cardinals to roar back,

especially in the second half, to seize a 60-45 victory. Pat Sabatino bucketed 16 points and Jaraad Rogers banged in 13 points for the Blue Devils.

A strategy that was successfully engineered, especially in the first quarter, by the Westfield High School girls basketball team, stunned the visiting Linden Tigers into a deficit they were unable to erase in the Blue Devils' crucial 43-39 victory on January 24. Usually predators, the 10-5 lady Tigers became the prey and the 11-4 Blue Devils became the predators. Gab O'Leary seized the offensive and led all scorers with 17 points - seven in the second quarter. Erin Miller finished with 10 points
