

COHEN BREAKS MEET RECORD IN 200-FREE AT 1:40.07

Raider Swim Girls Win UCT Crown; WF Girls, Boys 2nd

The Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School girls swim team rose to the occasion and won its fifth straight Union County Tournament championship at Sonny Werblin Pool at Rutgers University on January 27. The Raider girls squeaked by Westfield, 385-375, while the Cranford girls tied New Providence for sixth with a 159 total. Summit won the boys title with a total of 405 just ahead of the Blue Devil boys at 400 and the Raider boys placed third at 378, while the Cougars took sixth at 97.5.

Raiders Rachel Small, Bonhote, Chloe Howell and Abby Ryan took top honors in the 200-free relay at 1:40.36 just ahead of Blue Devils Thompson, Marcelina Krowinska, Julia McGann and Jeckell at 1:40.72. Cougars Nunziata, Riera, Wilson and O'Donnell finished fourth at 1:42.86. McGann, Jeckell, Krowinska and McKinney took first in the 400-free relay at 3:37.85 and Raiders Howell, Warren, Small and Ryan took second at 3:40.08.

Kudryashova broke the meet record in the 200-free at 1:49.04, followed by O'Donnell at 1:55.94, McGann at 1:57.49, Warren at 1:57.62 and Ryan at 1:59.87. Kudryashova also broke the meet record in the 100-free at 50.7, followed by Howell at 54.31. Raiders Small at 54.77 and Bonhote at 55.27 finished 4-5. Thompson took second in the 50-free at 24.91, followed by Bonhote at 25.02, Howell at 25.03 and Jeckell at 25.13.

Raider Alan Shao won the 200IM in 1:56.33, followed by Blue Devil Roan Baker at 1:58.41. Raider Aidan Treney finished sixth at 2:01.77. Shao also won the 100-fly in 52.69. Blue Devils Zach Youssef at 54.19 and Seth Camacho at 56.16 finished 3-6. Blue Devil Cooper Brennan took top honors in the 100-breast at 59.13 and teammate Barney Veres took third at 1:00.96.

Shao, Dan Donaldson, Matt London and Cohen took first in the 200-free relay at 1:28, followed closely by Blue Devils Jeremy Kronheimer, Baker, Youssef and Cooper Prieto at 1:28.62. Cougars Charles DeSimone, Gabe Graceffo, Mike DeSimone and Liam Loughlin took sixth at 1:39.03. Cohen, Shao, He and London won the 400-free relay in 3:14.13 and Youssef, Kronheimer, Tim McGann and Tom Moore took third at 3:21.17.

Prieto took second in the 100-free at 48.56. Kronhemier took fourth at 50.17 and London took fifth at 50.54. Prieto also took second in the 50-free at 21.89, followed by Kronheimer at 22.55, London at 22.79 and Donaldson at 22.95. Baker took second in the 100-back at 53.92 and Camacho finished sixth at 56.66.

Baker, Brennan, Youssef and Prieto finished second in the 200-medley at 1:36.62 and Raiders Treney, Jason Mongiovi, Donaldson and He finished fourth at 1:43.21.

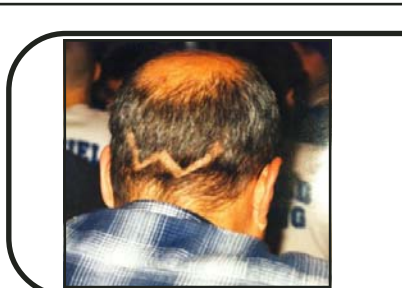

Boys swimming: Despite getting eight Top-15 all-time performances, the Blue Devils' seven-year reign as Union County champions ended in a wild three-way contest between Summit (405 points), WHS (400), and Scotch Plains (378).

The Devils' medley relay (Roan Baker, Tom Brennan, Zach Youssef, Cooper Prieto) went 1:36.62, the sixth fastest in school history, but lost by .03 of a second to Summit. Baker had WHS's fifth fastest 200IM (1:57.55) and ninth best 100 back (53.96), finishing second in both. Prieto's 21.89 was good for No. 2 in the county, and No. 13 all-time at WHS. Matt Swenson's 4:53.82 was the 14th fastest in school history, and fourth in the county. The 200 free relay (Jeremy Kronheimer, Baker, Youssef, Prieto) was second, and No. 10 all-time, while Brennan was WHS's only county champion, with a 59.13 that makes him the No. 8 all-time and the 10th sub-minute breaststroker in school history. Barney Veres was third in the event, and No. 12 all-time.

Girls swimming: The WHS girls came close, but Scotch Plains ran its county win streak to five in a row with a 10-point victory (385-375). The Devils won three events (medley relay, 200 IM and 400 free relay) had nine Top 15 all-time performances.

The medley relay (Keeley Thompson, Ellie Cestero, Abby McKinney, Viv Jeckell) swam the eighth-fastest time in school history. The 4x100 free relay (Julia McGann, Viv Jeckell, Marcelina Krowinska, McKinney) went 3:37.85. No. 13 all-time, McKinney's 2:11.23 won the IM and is No. 5 all-time, while her butterfly (58.59) was fourth place, and No. 3 all-time.

McGann's 1:57.49 was good for third place, and No. 8 all-time. McKinney Viv Jeckell's 25.13 in the 50 was fifth overall, and No. 15 all-time. Natalie Lee's 59.99 was fifth overall, and No. 10 all-time. Thompson was runner-up in the 100 back, but her 1.11 was No. 6 all-time. And Jenna Daniel finished sixth in the 100 breast, which is No. 12 all-time.
