a small mistake and I capitalized," McIntyre said.

Andrew Caminiti (2-for-3) also singled to right field in the first inning but was gunned down by Jamie Shiner as he attempted to stretch it into a double. Sean Flynn beat out an infield dribbler but Ruka got the third out when he fielded a grounder and tossed to first for the out.

McIntyre added his second hit when he pulled off a slick bunt single in the third inning.

"I saw the third baseman was pretty far back. Once I see that, I think it's a green light. I see that pretty much as tempting to bunt it. So why not? So right there I decided to bunt it," McIntyre explained.

Kohler's only tough inning was the fourth when the Cougars knotted the score. Jake DeClerico (1-for-3, 2 runs) reached first safely, Szczech walked then Murphy laid down a bunt single to load the bases with no one out. Joe Meola lofted an RBI sacrifice fly to center where McIntyre quickly fired to third, holding the runner at second. The next two Cougars flew out.

Ruka faced mild difficulty with two outs in the sixth when Caminiti ricocheted a hard infield single off his

glove and moved to second on a wild pitch. Coach McCaffery gave the signal to issue Flynn an intentional walk then the next batter flew out to center.

After Pancini struck out the first batter in the seventh, Tom Korzeneski hopped a single past short, Mike Meola slashed a single past first and Lucca Limera chopped an RBI single past third. Another run scored when Shiner's grounder was mishandled. Aidan Plick walked to load the bases then DeClerico got an easy RBI when he was walked.

Szczech sliced his two-run single to right then a double steal came next. Murphy walked and the stealing game continued until the seventh Cougar of the inning scuffed home plate.

"Coach McCaffery really doesn't believe in staying conservative during a game. We take every opportunity we can. When they changed the pitcher, we had first and second. First pitch we steal second and third to set up more runs," Szczech said.

With the exception to Mike Carlone getting hit by a pitch, Ruka retired the other three batters in the Westfield seventh.

Recently the Blue Devils' pitching has been holding its own but they

have been on the short side of several low-scoring games and need to get their bats working.

"We have the pitching. We have two, three solid starters. Once the bats come around, I think we can win a few games," McIntyre said.

"We have a really good deep pitching staff. Everyone comes out and does their jobs, throws strikes. It's been working the past couple of games. We just need to get the bats going," Kohler emphasized.

The top-seeded Cougars hosted eighth-seeded Summit in the quarterfinal round of the Union County Tournament on May 4.

"It's always great! Another rematch against Summit like last year. We are looking to putting a beating on them," Szczech said.

"That's why you play baseball. Games like those," Ruka expressed. "I can't wait for Saturday!"

Hobart's Aslanian Named Outstanding Senior Athlete

The Hobart College Athletic Department and the Statesmen Athletic Association honored the top student-athletes of 2018-19 at the annual Block H Awards Dinner tonight. Senior lacrosse attackman Chris Aslanian (The Hun School of Princeton/Westfield) was presented with the Francis L. "Babe" Kraus '24 Memorial Award as Hobart's most outstanding senior athlete.

Aslanian is the one of the most prolific scorers in Hobart's history. In 61 career games, he has 96 goals and 92 assists for 188 points. Aslanian holds the Statesmen's Division I era career records for assists and points. He is third in goals.

All-time, Aslanian is one of only six Statesmen to register at least 90 goals and at least 90 assists. He is seventh in career assists, 13th in career points and tied for 18th in career goals. Aslanian also has 63 ground

balls and 11 caused turnovers in his career. He was named the NEC Rookie of the Year in 2016 and was an All-NEC second team selection as a sophomore.

A starter in all 14 of Hobart's games this season, Aslanian leads the team with 32 assists and is second on the team with 55 points. With a six-point game against Mount St. Mary's, Aslanian became the seventh Division I Statesman to produce 50 or more points in a season. His 55 points are tied for third on the program's Division I era single-season list, four behind teammate Eric Holden and his 32 assists are second on the DI era single-season list behind Jamie Kirk '08 who had 38 in 2007. Aslanian had a season-high seven points on five goals and two assists against Canisius on February 9. Aslanian also scored five goals against The Mount on senior day.
