GENERAL ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF WESTFIELD CHAPTER 13, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", ARTICLE VII, "RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING", SEC. 13-53, "RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT ZONES"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Westfield of the County of Union, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Code of the Town of Westfield be and is hereby amended by revising Section 13-53 "Residential Parking Permit Zones", as follows:

(a) Designation of zones. The following locations are hereby designated as residential parking permits zones:

All zones established under Section 13-26 "Two hour zones - Unmetered" except" None.

(b) Establishment of subzones. The town clerk, or other town official designated by the Town Administrator, shall institute rules to limit parking of a vehicle to within a reasonable distance of the address of their residence.

(c) Marking of zones. Each residential parking permit zone shall be marked with signs at regular intervals indicating "No Parking Over 2 Hours Without Permit 8:00 am to 2 pm Monday - Friday"

SECTION II. Any or all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict, or inconsistent, with any part of the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in such conflict or inconsistent.

SECTION III. In the event that any section, part of provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court, such holdings shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall take effect after passage and publication as soon as, and in the manner, provided by law.
