## Mr. Gallagher to Participate In Bike Event to Fight Cancer

WESTFIELD - During the week-end of August 4 and 5, Edward Gallagher of Westfield will take part in the Pan-Massachusetts Challenge (PMC), a bike-a-thon presented by MFS Investment Management.

The event benefits the Jimmy Fund, which supports cancer research and care at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute in Boston.

Every summer for the past 21 years, cyclists have made the nearly 200-mile trek across Massachusetts to fight cancer. Mr. Gallagher will be among more than 3,500 riders who will take part in the 22nd PMC.

The PMC offers six routes, taking riders through as many as 43 Massachusetts towns. Participants may choose between four, two-day rides, which include the original 192-mile Sturbridge to Provincetown route, and two one-day rides.

Started as a loosely-organized event that raised \$10,200 in its first year, the PMC has grown into the Jimmy Fund's largest fundraiser for Dana-Farber. Last year, more than 2,800 PMC riders contributed

\$12.5 million to the Jimmy Fund, bringing the PMC's total contribution over 21 years to nearly \$55 million. This year's goal is to raise \$13 million.

Sealed proposals will be received by the Town of Westfield in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 425 East Broad Street, Westfield, New Jersey, at 10:00 AM prevailing time on Monday, July 2, 2001, for the "PROPOSED STORM SEWERS ON VARIOUS ROADS IN THE TOWN OF WESTFIELD, NEW JERSEY."

The work under this Proposal includes the furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work as shown on the Contract Drawings and described in the Contract Specifications, and Proposals shall be in accordance with such Drawings and Specifications and the terms proposed in the Contract.

The major items of work under this contract will include, but will not be limited to, the following in estimated quantities:

50 linear feet 8-inch High Density Polyethylene Pipe"; 60 linear feet 12-inch High Density Polyethylene Pipe"; 725 linear feet 15-inch High Density Polyethylene Pipe"; 645 linear feet 24-inch High Density Polyethylene Pipe"; 185 linear feet 30-inch High Density Polyethylene Pipe"; 10 Each Construct Various Type Inlets; 1 Each Construct Manhole; 2 cubic yards Construct New Headwall.

\* Reinforced Concrete and PVC Pipe replaced by High Density Polyethylene Pipe.

The successful bidder shall start construction ten (10) days after notice of award of Contract is given, and shall complete all work within sixty (60) calendar days after notice to proceed.

Proposals shall be in writing on the forms furnished and must be delivered at the place and before the hour above mentioned, and must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the Town of Westfield in an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the base amount of the bid, but not less than \$500.00 nor more than \$20,000.00. Each bid must also be accompanied by a Surety Company Certificate stating that said Surety company will provide the bidder with the required Performance bond in the full amount of the Contract, by a Non-Collusion Affidavit and a Contractor's Qualification Statement, Statement of Ownership, on the forms included in and explained in the contract documents.

Bidders must be in compliance with all provisions of Chapter 127 P.L. 1975 supplement to the law against discrimination (Affirmative Action) and must pay workmen the prevailing wage rates promulgated by the New Jersey State Department of Labor and Industry for this project, copies of which are on file in the Office of the Town Engineer.

### GENERAL ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF WESTFIELD CHAPTER 13, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" BY AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS THEREOF.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Westfield in the County of Union that the Code of the Town of Westfield, Chapter 13, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic" be amended in the following particulars:

SECTION I. That Section 13-20 "Parking Prohibited-At all Times" be amended by adding the following:

**East Broad Street** - Northwest Side-Beginning at the southwesterly curbline of Linden Avenue and extending fifty (50) feet southwesterly along the northwesterly curbline of East Broad Street.

Northwest Side-Beginning at the northeasterly curbline of Linden Avenue and extending fifty (50) feet northeasterly along the northeasterly curbline of East Broad Street.

Northwest Side-Beginning at the southwesterly curbline of Jefferson Avenue and extending fifty (50) feet southwesterly along the northwesterly curbline of East Broad Street.

**Linden Avenue** - Northeast Side-Beginning at the northwesterly curbline of East Broad Street and extending fifty (50) feet northwesterly along the northeasterly curbline of Linden Avenue.

Southwest Side-Beginning at the northwesterly curbline of East Broad Street and extending fifty (50) feet northwesterly along the southwesterly curbline of Linden Avenue.

SECTION II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict, or inconsistent, with any part of the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict or inconsistent.

SECTION III. In the event that any section, part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall take effect after passage and publication as soon as, and in the manner, provided by law.


