Exhibit and Talk to Focus On Negro League Baseball

WESTFIELD - On Thursday, November 8, the Westfield Community Center's after-school program will host a viewing and talk on an exhibit entitled "Somebody to Cheer For - Black Professional Baseball and African-American Community Life in New Jersey." Doors will open at 6 p.m.

The exhibit documents "an important, under-appreciated chapter in the history of the great American pastime," according to Ernestine Howell, the center's Executive Director.

It examines this aspect of baseball's history against the background of New Jersey's late 19th and early 20th century African-American community life.

Appearing for the program will be professors Lawrence Hogan of Union County College and Clement Price of Rutgers University in Newark.

Professor Hogan is one of the producers of the exhibit and co-producer of the film *Before You Can Jackie Robinson*, while Professor Price is a scholar on urban America

and author of "Freedom Not Far Distant - A History of African-Americans in New Jersey."

The children of the center's after-school program will perform a skit dedicated to the heroes of the Negro Leagues called "Legends of the Game."
