WHEREAS, Killam Associates submitted a Proposal dated August 8, 2001 to provide the professional engineering services necessary to prepare plans and specifications, perform additional testing of sediment as required and obtain all necessary permits to proceed with the rehabilitation work on a time and materials basis for a fee not to exceed \$59,750.00, and
