FSPY Swim Men Get 12th At 'Y' National Competition

Fanwood-Scotch Plains YMCA Men's 200-yard medley relay team finished in 12th place at the YMCA National Swimming Championships held April 2 through 5 at Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The team of Kevin Bobenchick (Sr. Backstroke), Steve Swenson (Sr. Breaststroke), Brian Gartner (Soph. Butterfly) and Eric Swenson (Soph. Freestyle) finished in 1:38.33, established a new team record and scored the first points for FSPY in national competition in 12 years.
 The FSPY national team was eight swimmers strong, including Ryan Hauptman (100 Backstroke/400 FR and MR), David Hauptman (200 FR/400 FR), Amanda Dickson (100 Breaststroke) and Maggie Gousman (50 Freestyle).
 Bobenchick also competed in the 50 free, 100 back and was on all the relays. Gousman's qualifying time of 25.3 established a team record for 13-14 girls. Gartner also competed in the 50 free, 200 IM and 100 fly and

was on two other relays. Gartner's fly qualifying time of 52.33 also established a new team record. Eric Swenson competed in the 100 and 200-yard breast and was a member of two other relays.
 Steve Swenson, recently named "All Area" in the breaststroke was FSPY's top individual finisher with a 17th place in the 200 breaststroke with a time of 2:09.92, ranking him second all-time at the Y behind Mike Zimmerman's 1980 performance of 2:09.75. Steve also finished 19th in the 100 breast with a time of 1:00.15.
 The relays were especially strong as the 400-medley relay team of Ryan Hauptman, Steve Swenson, Gartner and Bobenchick recorded a 21st national ranking with a time of 3:37.54, just 0.4 seconds off a top 16 finish. They placed second all time for the FSPY Piranha's in this event.
 FSPY swim team is coached by Westfield native and former FSPY swimmer Ed Pretre.
