Model Railroad Club Set To Expand Layout Room

COUNTY - The Model Railroad Club, Inc., an activity of the Union County Park System, has announced that its membership will remove the temporary walls separating the club's 60-foot by 80-foot building addition from the completed 40-square-foot HO scale model railroad display this Saturday, August 3. This will effectively triple the size of the model railroad layout room. "This is an important milestone in the club's long history," said Club President Ray Russell. "Taking down the wall brings us one giant step closer to obtaining a permanent certificate of occupancy for the expansion." The club's HO scale layout depicts a mainline railroad running from Hoboken to Pittsburgh, Pa. Part of the New Jersey portion of the layout is based on the old Lackawanna Railroad Morris and Essex Division, currently operated by NJ Transit. Club members plan to build and operate elements of Hoboken terminal and the surrounding tidewater area as it appeared in the 1950s as one of the main features of the expanded layout. The Model Railroad Club, Inc. was founded in 1949 in connection

of Paul Mallery, a pioneer of the hobby of model railroading. The club building is located off of Route 22, East, behind The Home Depot in Union. It was designed and built entirely by volunteers, who maintain it under an arrangement with the Union County Park System. 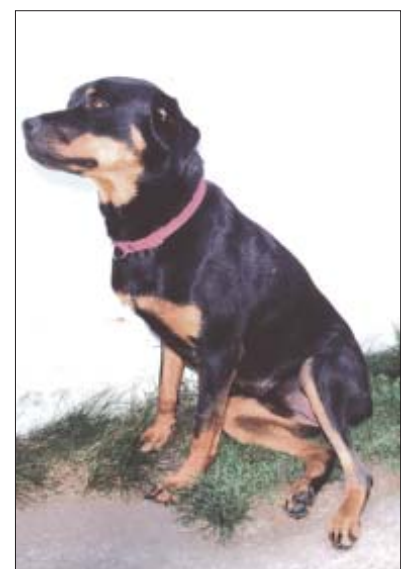
ability to walk. She must have surgery on both her legs.
