TOWN OF WESTFIELD BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT
The Board of Adjustment of the Town of Westfield, New Jersey will meet on Monday September 9, 2002 in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 425 East Broad Street, Westfield, New Jersey at 7:30 p.m. to hear and consider the following appeals for variance from the requirements of the Westfield Land Use Ordinance:

Jonathan and Karen Fishman, 23 Cornwall Drive seeking permission to erect an addition contrary to the requirements of Section 11.07 E7 of the Land Use Ordinance. Minimum rear yard setback proposed is 20 feet. Ordinance requires 35 feet.

South Side Roman Bistro, 338 South Avenue (Applicant, Sergio Marano) seeking permission to retain neon "open" sign that is prohibited by Section 16.07G of the Land Use Ordinance. Ordinance does not allow this type of signage.

John C. and Kimberly Baker, 519 Mountain Avenue seeking permission to erect a garage contrary to the requirements of Section 12.04 F1 and 13.01 I1 of the Land Use Ordinance. Maximum building coverage proposed is 21.5%. Ordinance allows 20%. The height of garage with cupola proposed is 16 feet 9 inches. Ordinance allows 15 feet.

Joan Mulholland, 837 Dorian Road seeking permission to erect an addition contrary to the requirements of Section 11.08 E.6. of the Land Use Ordinance. Applicant proposes side yard setback of 6 feet 9 inches. Ordinance requires 10 feet.

Richard and Pauline Harris, 640 Arlington Avenue seeking permission to erect an addition contrary to Section 12.04 F1 of the Land Use Ordinance. Maximum building coverage proposed is 20.57%. Ordinance allows 20%.

Charles Fallon, 910 Irving Avenue seeking permission to erect a hot tub contrary to Sections 12.04F1 and 13.02C3 of the Land Use Ordinance. Ordinance allows a maximum coverage of structures of 20% - applicant proposes 24.4%. Ordinance requires a free standing hot tub to be located 15 feet from the property lines - applicant proposes a setback of 10 feet.

Documentation of the above is on file in the Office of the Town Engineer, 959 North Avenue West, Westfield, New Jersey and may be seen Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Westfield White 10s Capture N. Providence League Title

The Westfield White baseball team clinched the championship of the New Providence PAL 10-Year-Old Division with decisive victories over Montville, Basking Ridge White and Basking Ridge Green. In the final week, Westfield drubbed its three closest rivals by a combined score of 50-18 and finished 12-2. Westfield White also defeated every league opponent, including the Westfield Silver and Blue teams that went on to win their respective playoffs.

In 14 games, the White scored an amazing 200 runs. Jonathan Russo and Joseph Macri, who each batted over .500, served as the table-setters, stealing bases and pushing runs across the plate in every game. Dylan Simon, Christian Rankin, J.T. Colucci, Bill Sickles and Mike Sheehan, each delivered extra base-clearing blasts throughout the season. Taylor Stevenson, Jonathan Erman, Justin Erickson, Max St. Lifer and Kyle Ripperger combined keen eyes at the plate with sharp base-running skills.

Pitching and defense also helped deliver the pennant. Sickles started the most games on the mound and patrolled centerfield with authority. Shortstop Macri anchored the infield with his slick play and amassed 30 innings on the mound, including scoreless relief appearances against Westfield Silver, Summit, Millburn and New Providence.

Simon and Colucci shared catching duties and combined to throw out five Millburn base runners. Russo at second and Sheehan in the outfield started every game at the same position. Outfielders Erickson in New Providence, Erman in Montville and Ripperger in Millburn made memorable catches.

The White's greatest victories, however, were teamwork, sportsmanship and friendship. Russo, Sheehan and St. Lifer demonstrated great dedication by playing in every game. The team proved its mettle by rallying from early deficits in almost half of its games and by supporting one another with timely hits and big defensive plays. It took selfless contributions from all 12 players to nail down the league crown.
