Westfield Red Cross Offers Babysitter Training Course

This summer the Westfield/Mountainside Chapter of the American Red Cross will be hosting four Babysitter's Training courses for youth ages 11 to 15 years old. The first class will be on July 9 and July 11 from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. both days. The second course will be on Saturday, July 27 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The third course will be on Saturday, August 10 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and the fourth course will be a three-night training on August 19, 20, and 21 from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

The training course is ideal for current and future babysitters. It teaches youth the best ways to keep the children in their care safe. Topics include making good decisions, supervising children of different ages, keeping everyone safe inside and outside, handling emergencies, age appropriate activities, performing basic infant care (feeding, diapering, burping) and some basic first aid. Participants are also given instruction in how to handle breathing emergencies such as rescue breathing and choking (Heimlich Maneuver). The course emphasizes the importance of youth handling their babysitting jobs in a professional manner. The classes are held at the Chapter House, located at 321 Elm Street in Westfield. The course includes a handbook and a small first aid kit. Pre-registration is required and space is limited.
