Union County CPAs Award Scholarships To Leichner, Busch

SCOTCH PLAINS - The New Jersey Society of Certified Public Accountants (NJSCPA)/Union County Chapter recently presented scholarship awards to Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School graduates Scott Leichner and Stephen Busch. The awards were presented on May 14. Scott is entering his sophomore year at the University of Central Florida. Stephen is attending James Madison University, where he is entering his junior year.

WESTFIELD - The Rotary Club of Westfield held its annual Scholarship Awards Luncheon on June 4. Sixteen of the grant recipients are graduating high school this year, five are now attending colleges and one is in law school. The recipients were luncheon guests during the presentation.

The scholarships awarded this year bring the total number of grants awarded since the inception of the club's scholarship program to 1,373. The financial aid given during the 60 years of the program now tallies \$1,517,000.

In selecting the recipients, the Scholarship Committee weighs academic records disclosing the student's ability to complete a proposed college program, the ability of the applicant to articulate the reason for pursuing a college education, the personal contribution of the applicant to their financial needs, the demonstration of their compliance with the club's motto, "Service Above Self" through their participation in school and/or community activities and, finally, to financial need.

The committee is chaired by Stanley Kaslusky, a Past President of the Rotary Club. Members include Alison Brafman, Roger Love, Jr., Mark Zenobia and Robert Read, also a Past President. The panel interviewed or reviewed the applications of 54 applicants before making the awards.

Two four-year Wallace Grants, which are administered through the Westfield Foundation, each in the amount of \$15,000, were awarded to Rosemary Topar and Andrew Pilecki.

Rosemary has been accepted at Montclair State University. She has noted decided a major, but hopes to continue her studies in music. Andrew will attend St. Joseph's and will major in psychology.

Four one-year Wallace Grants, each in the amount of \$2,500, were

granted to Ashley Carr, who will major in language at Brown University; Rui Lu, who has been accepted at John Hopkins University, where she will major in international relations; Pieter Van Iperen, who will major in drama in Tisch at New York University; and Rebecca Swenson, who will major in baking at The Culinary Institute of America in Hyde Park, N.Y.

A one-year grant of \$1,000, which was given in memory of Jimmy Coventry, former Rotary Treasurer and a moving force behind the club's scholarship program, was awarded to Lauren Baeder. She will attend Miami of Ohio, where she will major in international business.

The two Harry Sturke grants, each in the amount of \$1,000, were granted to Jackie Cusimano, who will attend St. Joseph's, but has not opted for a major, and Rachel Falcone, who has been accepted at Vassar College, where she intends to major in journalism.

The Georgianna F. Pollack Grant of \$1,000 was awarded to LaQuan McCoy, who will major in computer science at Howard University.

The Dodds Grant of \$1,000 was awarded to Marie Tracey, who has been accepted at Fordham University, where she will major in history.

One-year Rotary grants tallying \$1,000 each, were awarded to Robyn Jeffries, who has been accepted at Temple University, where she will major in filmmaking; Bree Sherry, who will attend Elon University, where she will major in English; Kristen Pollack, who will attend Loyola with an undecided major; Lan "Nicole" Dang, who has been accepted at Newark College, where she will major in pharmacy; and Leslie Brummell, who intends to major in business at Lynn University.

The following one-year Rotary scholarships, each \$1,000, were

awarded to the following Westfield High School graduates, who are currently attending colleges: Donald Bucciarelli is attending St. Peter's, majoring in accounting; Claire Tafelski, now attending Douglass College as a pre-law major; Maria Isoldi, now majoring in communications at Marist College; Andre Moore, who is attending Seton Hall University as a psychology major; and Timothy Kelman, a special education major at The College of New Jersey.

Two Robert and Winifred Read Law Scholarships of \$2,000 each were awarded to Frank Coppa, who will finish his last year at Rutgers Law School at Camden and to Sarah Lechner, who will commence her studies at Rutgers Law School in Newark.

The two Linda Read Memorial Scholarships, tallying \$1,250 each, which are available to pupils who will major in nursing or who will take pre-medicine studies, were not awarded. There were no qualified applicants.

Club President Jane Sentivan expressed her appreciation for the "diligent and tireless" efforts of the members of the Scholarship Committee who interviewed all of the high school applicants and reviewed the applications of all of the college students before making the final determination of the grants to be awarded.

Ms. Sentivan also thanked the members of the Rotary Club of Westfield for their efforts and success in conducting the Rotary's annual Pancake Day, which was held last March.
