Historical Society to Hear About Mme. de Pompadour

WESTFIELD - "The Patronage of Mme. de Pompadour at the Court of Versailles, 1745-1764: Art, Politics and Enlightenment" will be discussed by Rosamond Hooper-Hamersley in a slide and lecture presentation to the Westfield Historical Society on Friday, March 15, at 7:30 p.m. in the Community Room of the Westfield Municipal Building, located at 425 East Broad Street in Westfield.

Pompadour came to play in the currents of change which swept through France between 1745 and 1764, the year of her death.

The guest speaker is the wife of the Reverend Andrew Hamersley, an Episcopal priest and the Rector of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Westfield. They have two children, Samantha, a sophomore at Westfield High School, and James, a student at Roosevelt Intermediate School.

The event is free and open to the public. Light refreshments will be served at the conclusion of the program.

Her topic is based on the doctoral dissertation she defended in October 2000 before the University at Albany, where she had attained her Master of Arts Degree in History in 1994.

She said the nature of her research uses art as evidence to explain cultural, artistic and political changes in France in the 30 years before the revolution of 1789, a time of great upheaval.
