Claire J. Gray Acting Town Clerk GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 1846 AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT DEDICATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF SPRINGFIELD AVENUE AND CARDINAL DRIVE IN THE TOWN OF WESTFIELD

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Department of Transportation (the "State") and the Union County Department of Engineering and Planning (the "County") previously determined that certain improvements to the intersection of Springfield Avenue and Cardinal Drive (the "Intersection"), including the installation of a traffic signal, would be beneficial to the State, County and Town residents; and

WHEREAS, owners of certain properties on Cardinal Drive previously agreed to fund the improvements and the installation of the traffic signal at the Intersection; and

WHEREAS, Etnorr Partners, LLC, 301 Livingston Avenue, Livingston, New Jersey, had previously received preliminary and final approval from the New Jersey Department of Transportation and Union County Department of Engineering and Planning to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Cardinal Drive and Springfield Avenue and otherwise improve the intersection as required under the plans approved by the State and County; and

WHEREAS, Warren K. Hanscom owns certain real property located in the Borough of Mountainside, County of Union, and State of New Jersey, which real property is adjacent to the Intersection (the "Hanscom Property"); and whereas on April 5, 2002 Warren Hanscom executed a Deed of Easement in favor of the Town of Westfield (the "Easement") which grants certain perpetual rights of access to the Hanscom Property, including an easement for construction and maintenance purposes and as well as a right of way; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Special Ordinance 2061 adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Westfield on July 2, 2002, the Town accepted the perpetual rights of access granted by way of the Easement, which rights include an easement for construction and maintenance and a right of way; and

WHEREAS, on November 22, 2002 said Easement was recorded by the Union County Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2002 the Town of Westfield entered into a Developers Agreement with Etnorr Partners, LLC for the Intersection improvements including installation of the traffic signal at the Intersection of Springfield Avenue and Cardinal Drive in the Town of Westfield; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Developers Agreement, upon completion of the signal installation and related improvements and final approval by the State, Etnorr Partners, LLC is to transfer the traffic signal to the Town of Westfield and the Town of Westfield will assume responsibility for the maintenance and operation of the traffic signal after a one year period during which time Etnorr Partners, LLC, shall be responsible for the maintenance of the traffic signal; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2003 the traffic signal installation received final approval from the New Jersey Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Westfield Town Council has determined that it is in the public interest to accept the transfer and dedication of the traffic signal at the Intersection of Springfield Avenue and Cardinal Drive as said traffic signal has improved the Intersection and will thereby improve the safety and welfare of the residents of the Town of Westfield; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Westfield in the County of Union:

SECTION I The Town of Westfield, pursuant to the terms of the Developers Agreement dated August 6, 2002, hereby accepts the transfer of, and hereby dedicates, the traffic signal located at the intersection of Springfield Avenue and Cardinal Drive within the Town of Westfield from Etnorr Partners, LLC.

SECTION II Any of all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict, or inconsistent, with any part of the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in such conflict or inconsistent.

SECTION III In the event that any section, part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court, such holdings shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so held unconstitutional or invalid.
