The Scotch Plains Fanwood (SPF) 8-year-old tournament team captured first in the Cranford tournament with a resounding, 15-1, four-inning victory over Berkeley Heights. Prior to the final game, SPF finished a perfect 5-0 in the preliminary round, outscoring its opponents by an impressive 52-5 margin. SPF beat

Cranford, 11-0; topped Manalapan, 6-4; beat Berkeley Heights, 14-0; outscored Clark, 10-1 and shutout Long Hill, 11-0.
