Miller-Cory Announces Basket Making Event

WESTFIELD - A demonstration on how to create baskets from natural materials will take place this Sunday, May 15, from 2 to 4 p.m. at the Miller-Cory House Museum, located at 614 Mountain Avenue in Westfield.

Eileen O'Shea of Summit will show how useful and decorative containers can be made from materials such as reed, bark and vines. Before pottery, tinware and glass were easily accessible, 18th and 19th century families settling in the west fields of Elizabethtown used baskets as their primary storage containers.

Volunteers dressed in authentic early American costumes will conduct tours of the 1740 farmhouse and

answer questions about early Colonial living in New Jersey. The last tour will begin at 3:30 p.m.

Members of the museum's Cooking Committee will demonstrate open-hearth cooking using the same methods, tools and techniques of the 18th century. Taste treats will be available for visitors to sample. The museum's gift shop also will be open.

A demonstration on the art of tole painting will take place on Sunday, May 22, starting at 2 p.m. Admission to the museum is \$2 for adults, 50 cents for students and free for children under six. For more information, please call the museum at (908) 232-1776.
