

Atlantic Arsenal Crowned State U12 Basketball Champs

The Atlantic Arsenal Basketball Club, based in Westfield, recently won the 2005 NJ AAU Division II State Championship for Under-12 Boys. The team plays AAU tournaments in the tri-state area each spring.

The Arsenal defeated the Central Jersey Hawks in the semifinals, 63-51, in a game featuring great shooting. Peter Niotis scored 11 points. Joe Greenspan and Sean Siburn contributed clutch hoops in the third quarter. Joey Kacmarsky hit an incredible 14-14 from the free throw line, 10 of which came in the last few minutes. Scott Miller and Jordan Toczynski contributed nice defense on the other end.

The State Championship game was a hard fought battle in which the Arsenal knocked off the New Jersey Spartans, 37-36, on a last-second shot by Ryan Murray. The game featured tremendous defense led by John Serzan and Clayton Johnson.

Scott Sowinski got the Arsenal off to a great start, as he played a terrific

first quarter. Ryan Hess and Conor Skea each scored 10 points, and Greg Thomson showed great leadership. With the Arsenal down by two points, Murray hit a game winning 3-pointer with seven seconds left.

A final defensive stop gave the Atlantic Arsenal Basketball Club its second state championship in its history, and the first for the current group.
