Net Man McGlynn Captures WTA Men's Masters Crown

Mike McGlynn won the second and third sets to defeat runner-up Henry Williams for the 2005 Westfield Tennis Association Masters crown, on October 1.

In the first set, both players held serve for most of the set. Williams broke McGlynn's serve to win the set, 7-5. McGlynn answered by winning the second set, 6-1, and featured a game with eight deuces. In the third set, McGlynn built a 4-1 advantage. Williams fought back and evened the score at 4-4. McGlynn then won the final two games to ice the set 6-4 and the match.

Westfield marched to the 10-yard line on its opening drive but fumbled to end the drive. Backs Brian Githens and Keegan Hess highlighted the drive with aggressive runs.

Millburn then marched to the Westfield 11 before the defense stuffed them on a fourth-and-six attempt. Linebacker Dillon Rolnick and linemen Michael Carlino, Liam Devin and Colin Barber helped end the drive with fine tackles.

Westfield got on the board at the end of the half on a nicely executed pass from quarterback Charlie Callinan to wide out Brett Glenn for a 10-yard TD completion. The PAT was no good.

The Blue Devils struck quickly in the second half behind strong running by Jake Greenberg and Kell Dolan. Wide out Kevin Mikovitz then took a reverse handoff from quarterback Quinn Dursee and scampered 20 yards for the TD. The PAT failed. Millburn responded with a nice off-tackle run that netted 44 yards and a TD, and successfully executed the PAT, closing the gap 12-7.
