

WF Methodist Church Features S. African Dance

WESTFIELD - Friday Evening Classics moves into its fall schedule this month at the Westfield First United Methodist Church, One East Broad Street. The first of two concerts will be this Friday, October 21, at 7:30 PM. Featured will be the exciting choral and dance displays of Thula Sizwe ("Hush and Listen!"), an eleven-man a cappella singing group from South Africa.

Born out of love of country, family and traditional African harmony and dance, Thula Sizwe displays a blend of uplifting voices, dance and percussive African rhythms. Thula Sizwe performances take many forms, including slow ballads, traditional song-and-dance routines and gospel music in the Zulu tradition.

The musical style of Thula Sizwe is based in ancient Zulu cultural traditions. The essence of this style is "call and response," with a leader selecting the piece to be sung, setting the tone with an initial phrase and sparking a response from the other members of the group. Many of the songs sung by the group are in this style.

The group performed in a variety of settings, including Paul Simon's 1992 Graceland concert and the 1994 inauguration of President Nelson Mandela. More recently,

they have toured China, Germany, Turkey, the Netherlands and the United States. They have made several CD's, two of which are available for sale.

Looking ahead, a special Halloween event is planned for Saturday, October 29 in the church sanctuary. Admission for the Thule Sizwe concert is \$10 for adults and \$5 for children 12 and under. No reservations are necessary. There is plentiful parking in the church lot accessible from Ferris Place. Parking is also available in nearby lots and on street. The church and sanctuary are handicap accessible. For more information, call the church office daily from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
