## Raider Boys Win 3, Devils 1 At Raider Track Relays

The Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School boys won three events and established meet records in two of them at the Raider Relays in Hillsborough on April 22. The Westfield High School boys won one event, grabbed one second, one third and four fifth places.

Raiders Kyle Rowbotham, with a meet-best 41'8.5", and Nehemiah Burney-Porter broke the old meet record of 78'8.75" set by Union in 2004 in the triple jump with a combined distance of 82'4". The Blue Devils placed fifth in the event at 74'5.5". Robotham, James Alfano and Tom Pennella finished first in the 400 intermediate hurdles with a time of 2:58.3. Robotham ran his leg in 55.4. He also split 52.1 on the third-place 1600-meter relay and ran a 15.1 on the sixth-place shuttle hurdles.

Mike Alleman had the best toss in the shot put at 52'9.5" and John Badala had a toss of 48'3" as the Raider twosome broke the meet record of 100'0.5" set by Manalapan in 2004 with a distance of 101'0.5". Union Catholic took sixth in the event at 84.8.75". Alleman also had the best toss in the discus at 130'2" to lead his twosome to third in the event with a distance of 229'6". The Vikings took

sixth at 227'9".

Blue Devils Evan Friedman (4:38.9), Jeff Perrella (4:25.8), Kris Kagan (4:49.4) and Jay Hoban (4:43.8) won the 6400-meter relay with a time of 18:38. The Blue Devils also placed second in the 3200-relay at 8:27.2. Union Catholic was fifth at 8:32. Westfield took third in the pole vault at 19 feet, tied for fifth in the high jump at 11'1" and fifth in the sprint medley at 55 seconds. The Raiders placed fourth in the distance medley at 11:18 followed by the Vikings at 11:23. The Vikings finished second in the 800-meter relay with a time of 1:34.9 and the Raiders were fifth at 1:37.1. The Raiders took fourth in the javelin with a distance of 254'2" and sixth in the long jump at 36'7.75 behind the Blue Devils at 36.8.5".

Blue Devils Meg and Rose Driscoll, Ayn Wisler and Stephanie Cortinhal placed second in the girls 4x800 with a time of 9:54.9. The Raider girls placed third in the 4x400 at 4:20.8 followed by the Vikings at 4:26.8. The Raiders also took third in the shot put at 62'10.5" and sixth in the discus at 167'1". The Vikings placed third in the high jump at 9'8" and fourth in the 4x100 at 51.7 and the 4x200 at 1:50.7.
