I. BACKGROUND/PROJECT DESCRIPTION:
 The Town of Westfield requires professional architectural services for renovations to the Public Works Complex, located at 959 North Avenue West, Westfield. The Center houses the Department of Public Works, which includes Public Works, Engineering, Planning/Zoning and Construction Permit functions.
 Due to increased staff, customer service and code compliance requirements, the Town has identified the need for reconfiguration and expansion of the existing building, including, but not necessarily limited to, the following:
 § Addition of a reception/information vestibule at the main entrance to the Center.
 § Addition of two office rooms at the rear of the Center.
 § Public restrooms within the existing building which meet ADA accessibility requirements.
 A conceptual plan depicting the proposed renovations, entitled "Proposed Office Layout Plan-Department of Public Works Building" dated January 23, 2006, has been prepared by the Town Division of Engineering and copies are available at the Town Engineer's Office within the Public Works Center.
 It is the Town's desire to receive delivery of construction documents by close of business on March 5, 2007.
II. SCOPE OF SERVICES:
Phase I - Evaluation of office needs as depicted on the Conceptual Plan described in Section I above, preparation of new conceptual plans and meetings with Town staff as required.
Phase II - Preparation of architectural plans and specifications and construction bid documents, and assistance with the bid process and award of construction contract.
Phase III - Construction observation services if required by the Town.
 The Town may award a contract for any one, or all, of the above phases of work. Proposals should address all project phases.

 7. The above information should be furnished for each of the consultants or specialists that you intend to use.
 8. Additional information you feel should be considered in evaluating your firm's ability to perform the work.
 9. Anticipated range of fees for each project phase shown above.
 10. Ten (10) copies of the proposal (no faxes).
 11. Projected project schedule, which conforms to the Town's timetable goals included in Section I. BACKGROUND/PROJECT DESCRIPTION.
