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## County Household Waste Recycling Set for October 21

ROSELLE – Union County will hold a recycling event on Saturday, October 21, for residents to dispose of household special waste, old automobile tires and mercury fever thermometers in an environmentally safe manner. The collection will take place from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Warinanco Park Ice Skating Center, off Thompson Avenue in Roselle.

Pre-registration is not required, you must be a county resident and have identification, businesses not allowed and there is no charge.

Workers at the site will unload the vehicles. There is a limit of eight automobile tires (without rims) per household.

Union County residents can turn in their old mercury fever thermometers and receive a new mercury-free digital thermometer, free of charge. One digital thermometer per household will be provided (while supplies last) regardless of the number of mercury thermometers dropped off. Please bring thermometers in a sealed plastic bag to prevent release in case of accidental breakage.

Household special waste" includes oil-based paint and varnish, antifreeze, aerosol cans, pool chemicals, corrosives, pesticides, herbicides, solvents, thinners, fire extinguishers, motor oil and oil filters, gasoline, batteries, thermostats, fluorescent bulbs (unbroken), blood pressure devices, and mercury switches. Only materials in original or labeled containers will be accepted. No containers larger than five gallons will be accepted.

Latex (water-based) paint and empty cans will not be accepted. They should

be disposed of in with the regular garbage. Leftover latex paint can be air-dried or, to hasten the drying process, kitty litter and/or newspaper can be added to hasten the drying.
