Jump Start Students Host Butterfly Parade at Brunner

SCOTCH PLAINS - The children in Bernadette Hoyer's Jump Start classes at Brunner School in Scotch Plains held a Butterfly Parade and Monarch Migration Celebration on October 4. The parade was the culminating activity for a learning adventure that began on the first day of school in September, when the children were introduced to dozens of Monarch caterpillars in the classroom. The students were able to experience each stage of metamorphosis as it took place. Through books and songs they also learned about the monarch migration to Mexico each fall. Parents had opportunities to go into the classroom and share the experience with their children as the caterpillars grew and changed.

The students, decked out in monarch wings and antennae, held the parade to celebrate all that they had learned and to give 40 monarch butterflies a special send-off to Mexico. The children sang the "Metamorphosis Song" during the parade and encouraged spectators to plant milkweed to help conserve the monarch butterfly population. The Brunner school student body, staff members and family members of the Jump Start students attended. The 40 monarchs released at the parade, as well as 53 others, were reared from monarch eggs and caterpillars found by Mrs. Hoyer on the milkweed plants in the Brunner children's garden and on milkweed plants in her backyard during the summer. Some of the children also found caterpillars in the school garden during the month of September.
