### WF's DeCampo Places In Mat Invitational

ALLENTOWN, PA. - Junior Joe DeCampo of Westfield helped the Muhlenberg College wrestling team to the championship of the Washington & Lee Invitational. DeCampo went 3-1 to finish third at 149 pounds. After dropping his first bout, DeCampo breezed through the consolation bracket with a pin, technical fall and major decision. The pin came in 38 seconds and was the fastest of his career.

DeCampo is 12-7 for the season and has placed in three tournaments. He has a career record of 45-30. The Mules finished first with 86 points, 8.5 more than second-place Johns Hopkins. The tournament title was the first for Muhlenberg since the 1995 Centennial Conference Championships, and its last regular-season tourney championship came at York in 1992.
