**Westfield White 9U Rebounds With Three-Win Streak**

After suffering a heartbreaking one-run loss to top-seeded Kenilworth, the Westfield White 9U baseball team rebounded with three victories to bring its division record to 5-4.

Westfield defeated the Summit Maroon team, 21-8. Starting pitcher Michael Jeffrey retired the side using only eight pitches in the first inning, and in relief, Ryan Bowman and Bobby Abbott silenced Summit. Shortstop Jordan Hinds snagged a line drive for an out and then threw to first to nail the runner off the bag. JD Mamer whacked a bases-clearing triple in the sixth. It was his fourth hit of the game and third extra-base hit. Liam Heinbokel reached base safely four times and ended the game with an unassisted double play at first.

In a 13-6 win against Cranford at Gumpert Field in Westfield, Abbott struck out five batters over three innings. First baseman Ethan Proveznak grabbed a high popup and a hard-hit grounder to record two outs in the

second inning. Austin Kreusser made a spectacular catch and throw from his knees to put a runner out at first, and Peter Walter prevented possible home runs with tough catches deep in the outfield.

In the fifth inning, second baseman Thomas Sabato flipped to first for the first out and caught a high popup to end it. Pitcher Holden Sabato held Cranford to three runs over three innings. Steve Barmakian hit his second home run of the season, a three-run shot.

Westfield then topped Basking Ridge at home. A perfect relay from outfielder Bowman to T. Sabato to throw out a runner at third shut down Basking Ridge's final scoring attempt. Heinbokel, Hinds, Kreusser and Mamer all drove in two or more runs, while Proveznak on the mound worked three outs in a row to close the game.
