WF 'White' 11s Advance In Rahway Tournament

The Westfield White 11-year-old team advanced in Rahway's Inaugural Summer Invitational Baseball Tournament by defeating the North Brunswick Raiders, 14-1, on July 15. The victory raised Westfield's season mark to 10-5 and 2-2 in the tournament.

Westfield plated eight runs in the first inning. Catcher Tom Gerris rapped a leadoff single to centerfield. Mark Lazzarotti nailed a two-run home run down the leftfield line. Calvin Robertshaw followed with a single and scored when David Kane drove a pitch to the fence for his third home run of the season.

Up 4-0 with no outs, Brad Norris drilled a line drive double, Matt Archambault walked and Justin Slavin sacrificed. Frank Pinney hit a screaming two-run single. Matt Lazzarotti singled and scored on an overthrow.

Westfield added four more in the second inning, highlighted by back-

to-back home runs from Gerris and Mark Lazzarotti. Robertshaw and Kane singled, then Norris and Archambault followed with RBI. In the fourth, Norris belted a two-run home run.

Marc Cavallo, Jack Dumont and Nick Mennona all contributed to the win. Archambault, Kane and Matt Lazzarotti took care of the pitching duties, limiting the Raiders to two hits.

On July 14, Cranford beat Westfield 19-6. Robertshaw tripled, and Kane hammered a home run over the centerfield fence. Dumont, Gerris and Mark Lazzarotti added solid hitting. Brendin Halipin and Javier Roman pitched for Cranford, while Justin Bakie added two home runs.

Earlier in the week, Westfield beat Rahway 13-3 (tournament) and Bridgewater 12-4 (regular season). The Westfield Blue avenged an earlier season loss to the White with a 10-8 victory (tournament).

Westfield White 11U Capture Edison Summer Fun Tourney

Down 10-6 in the bottom of the fifth, Westfield scored seven runs to secure the championship.

"This was a total team effort from top to bottom! Everyone hit and Chris Sweeney pitched four very solid innings with Dylan Elliott shutting down North Brunswick in their last

two at bats," said coach Smoot.

Throughout the tournament, Westfield was led by a very high scoring offense. Marc Luino, Matt Storcks, and Tom Randazzo all helped provide the spark needed at the top of the order, helping set the table for Elliott, Peter Zecca, Matthew Smoot, Jacob Wasserman, Christopher Arena, Conner Cummings, as well as Connor Hagan, Patrick Decker and Sweeney, who all had timely hits and key RBI.

"We all hope to return next season to continue to improve on playing on the bigger field and having some more fun," said Assistant Coaches Marc Luino and Frank Arena.
