Bayard's single got things started in the bottom of the third. Bonadies and D'Annunzio drew walks and Ridge triggered an RBI double to narrow the deficit, 8-6.

Three more Raiders scored in the fifth. Bonadies got tagged by a pitch and swiped a base. D'Annunzio walked and Ridge hopped a single past short to load 'em up. Pinch hitter Tom Hercel slashed an RBI single then Livent walked in two runs, putting the Raiders on top, 9-8. In the sixth, Ramos cracked his solo homer. After Livent walked and stole a base, Nielsen Herrera sliced a shot to third where Ridge made a brilliant major league diving catch.

"After giving up that home run, I was getting a little worried, but it was

a nice piece of hitting on his part," said Hubbard.

Bonadies tapped a leadoff single in the sixth and stole second. D'Annunzio and Ridge both laid down perfect bunt singles and Wolff spanked a two-run single. Maroney unloaded a double, scoring pinch runner Hercel to put the Raiders on top, 12-9.

"James Dinizo is hurt and could not catch. Wolff has basically been a bullpen catcher, warming up pitchers and not getting much time," said Bayard. "Today he got his opportunity and came up with a big single that gave us some breathing room."

In the Elizabeth seventh, Gene Caro led off with a walk and swiped second. Ken Russell stroked deep to D'Annunzio, who made a diving and sliding catch. Antoine made an outstanding grab in right and Bayard closed the curtain by scooping up a sharp line drive.

"I gave up a homerun which hurt but I managed to battle back from that," said Hubbard. "Wolff did a great job behind the plate. My fielders bailed me out, especially in that last inning, and our hitting was clutch, so everything worked out."

"This team is scrappy. We do all the little things and do whatever it takes to win. No one is selfish and they all want to win. It's about team and, 'we together', concluded Bayard. "I'm happy for the seniors. We owe a lot to them and they did a lot for the program. Hopefully these young guys can follow in their footsteps so we can continue to win more championships."
