

Westfield Wildcats Improve Hoops Season Record to 39-4

The Westfield Wildcats fifth grade Travel Basketball improved to 39-4 over the past weekend and have tucked several championships under its belt.

The Wildcats participated in the pre-season Wayne PAL Thanksgiving Shootout and lost by three points in the championship game to Wayne PAL. The Wildcats played in the Garden State League (GSL) and the Central Jersey (CJ) Basketball League, finishing 10-2 and 9-1, respectively, in the regular season games and tying for first place in both leagues.

The Wildcats defended their GSL title by defeating Immaculate Heart of Mary of Scotch Plains, this past Sunday. The CJ league championship game with defending champs East Brunswick, whom the Wildcats defeated earlier by one point (their only loss), is set for this upcoming week.

The Wildcats have also won the Fast Break Invitational Tournament, featuring 12 teams representing New Jersey, New York and Connecticut. They battled their way to the championship and beat a team from Queens, New York, in overtime. The Wildcats participated in and defended their title at the Clark Holiday Basketball

tournament by topping a tough Cranford team.

After winning their first three games, the Wildcats will face Basking Ridge in the Branchburg March Madness Tournament championship game. Basking Ridge defeated Westfield earlier this season. FSPY Swim Girls Win 6 Events, Set 3 Records at State Y Meet

The Fanwood-Scotch Plains (FSPY) girls swim team, coached by Chris Feintheil, won three individual and three relays, set three meet records and placed seventh at the Y Championship meet on March 9-11.

15-18 Melissa Helock won the 1,000-free with a meet record 10:29.09 and placed sixth in the 500-free. In the 200 free, Janene Senofonte and Helock touched 7-14, respectively. Meaghan Gaynor, Adriana Lyons, Nicole Colucci, Senofonte and Liz Hawkins touched 1-2-5-7-15, respectively, in the 50-free. In the 100-free, Lyons, Senofonte, Jillian Murphy and Colucci touched 2-8-11-15, respectively.

Gaynor, Murphy, Senofonte and Hawkins touched 3-4-8-13 in the 100-fly. Mary Henkels, Colucci, Murphy and Hawkins touched 4-9-11-15, respectively, in the 100-back. Gaynor and Kaitlin McGeehan finished 6-8 in the 100-breaststroke. McGeehan touched 11th in the 200-breast. Darrell Ann Smith placed in the 400IM (10th), 200IM (15th) and 500-free (16th).

Colucci, Senofonte, Hawkins and Gaynor won the 200-free relay with a meet record (1:39.03). Adriana Lyons, Henkels, McGeehan and Brittany Reyes won the 200-medley relay with a meet record (1:50.46). Murphy,

Senofonte, Hawkins and Lyons won the 400-free relay. Henkels, McGeehan, Gaynor and Lyons finished second in the 400-medley relay.

The 13-14s, comprised of Stephanie Baliko, Hannah Markey, Jessica Colucci, Kelly Gajdzisz (free only) and Rebecca Dunn (medley only), took 5-6, respectively, in the 200-medley and 200-free relays. Gajdzisz scored in five freestyle events - 200 (eighth), 100 (12th), 1,000 (13th), 500 (14th) and 50 (16th). Colucci touched 11th in 50-free. Baliko and Markey finished 7-13, respectively, in the 200-breast.

11-12 Micaela Lyons won the 50-free and finished 16th in the 200-free. Lyons and Nicole DePaola placed 13-15, respectively, in the 100-back. DePaola touched 14th in the 200-back. Lyons, DePaola, Jessica Cronin and Melissa Keiser took 14th in the 200-free relay.

10U Jody Thompson finished third in the 50-and 100-breaststroke and 14th in the 100-IM. Sarah Cronin placed in the 200-free (fourth), 200IM (fifth), 100-free (fifth), 50-free (eighth), 50-back (eighth) and 100-back (15th). Cronin, Thompson, Emma Sherry and Julie Haggan placed 9-14 in the 200-medley relay and 200-free relay, respectively.

FSPY Boys Win 7 Events, Set 3 Records at State Meet

The Fanwood-Scotch Plains (FSPY) boys swim team, coached by Chris Feintheil, finished eighth among the 39 teams at the state Y championships, won seven events and set three meet records on March 9-11. The FSPY boys and girls finished seventh overall, which is the highest placement at in over 15 years.

15-18 Scot Marino and 11-12 Greg Baliko spearheaded a strong performance. Marino won the 200-IM, 200-breast, 100-breast and 100-free, setting meet records in the 200-IM (1:52.21) and in the 200-breast (2:06.12). He touched second in the 400-IM and the 100-fly. Marino, Phil Luzny, Mike Miller, Brian O'Donnell,

placed fourth in the 400-free relay. Marino, Luzny, Mike Miller and Zach Peart took fifth in the 400-medley relay. Luzny, Livolsi and Miller took 4-14th-15th in the 200-fly. Peart finished 13th in the 200-backstroke.

Greg Baliko won the 200-IM, 100-fly (meet record 1:08) and 50-fly. He placed second in the 200-breast and third in the 100-IM, 100-breast and 200-free. Baliko, Joe Dunn, Ryan Gajdzisz and Ryan McKenna placed fourth in the 200-free relay and 200-medley relay. Dunn placed in the 200-fly (sixth), 50-fly (eighth), 200IM (ninth), 100-fly (ninth), 100-free (11th) and 100IM (12th). Gajdzisz scored in the 50-back (seventh), 200-back (ninth), 100-back (11th), 200-free (11th), 50-free (13th) and 100-free (13th).

10U Jeff Peart scored in the 50-breast (fifth), 50-free (sixth), 200-free (seventh), 100-breast (eighth) and 100-IM (11th), in the 10 and under age group. Peart, Matthew Giardello, Matthew Marino and Andrew DeBiasse touched eighth in the 200-free relay. Peart, Alex Skoog, Marino and DeBiasse took 16th in the 200-medley relay.

The 12-14 boys placed 9-10, respectively, in the 200-yard free and medley relays (Dan Napolitano, Mike Napolitano, Timothy Foster, Alex Burzynski). Mike Napolitano and Burzynski placed 14-15, respectively, in the 200-fly and 100-breast.
