

## UC U19 Rugby Boys Roll To Metro Championship

The Union County Rugby Football Club (UCRFC) U19 boys' team won its fourth consecutive METNY D2 championship on May 13. This year the team had to work hard to gain the championship as they only made the playoffs as a wild card and No. 4 seed.

In the semifinal against top-seeded East Islip (Long Island), UCRFC played a perfect first half as JT Sheehan and Chris Sheehan each scored a try. Tim Jacob added two penalty kicks and one conversion to give the team an 18-0 lead at the half.

In the second half, East Islip mounted a rally but JT Sheehan's second try and one by Pat Stanley sealed the victory. The final score read UCRFC 28, East Islip 14.

In the final, UCRFC played unde-

feated, second-seeded Fairfield (CT) High School. The UCRFC team overcame some early jitters and held a 3-0 lead at the half on the strength of a Tim Jacob penalty kick. UCRFC pressured Fairfield with numerous attacks into Fairfield's territory. Although, these attacks did not produce a try, the pressure forced Fairfield into numerous penalties and Jacob calmly made three more kicks to give UCRFC a 12-0 lead.

Fairfield finally broke the UCRFC defense and scored a converted try to make the score, 12-7. Late in the half, Bill Quinn intercepted a Fairfield pass and ran 50 meters for a try. Fairfield scored a late try but it was too little, too late and UCRFC were champions with a 17-12 win.

The UCRFC U19 girls' team also racked up a win by beating New York Rugby Club U19, 40-5, in their play-off match. Julia Watkins scored four tries and Olivia Dawson had three tries. Anna Morton added a try. Next up for the girls will be a rematch with Kingston in a game that will decide third place in the league.
