Local community organizations such as the Union Hospital, Plainfield Rescue Squad and Rahway Day Care Center have especially benefited from the service and leadership of these young people.

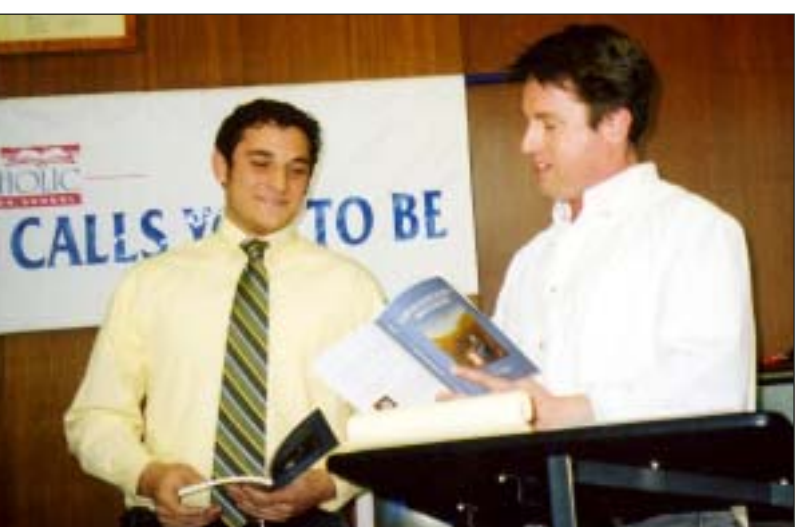
