Blue Devil Boys Take First At Kearny Track Relays

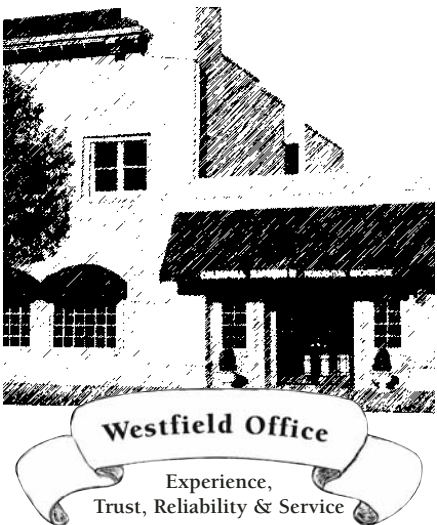
