Senior forward Morgan Miller pumped in 25 points, bringing her career total to 985, to lead the 18-3 Cranford High School girls basketball team to a 57-26 victory over 10-14 Benedictine Academy of Elizabeth in Cranford on February 9.

Just six days before, the Lady Cougars knocked Governor Livingston

Teamwork paid off as the Cranford High School boys basketball team dished out 16 assists that led to easy lay-ups and eight 3-pointers to overcome St. Mary's of Elizabeth, 57-50, in Cranford on February 7.

Senior point-guard Sean Babos distributed, at least, his fair share to

finish with five assists, before sinking the bulk of his 11 points, which included a pair of 3-pointers.

"I like to get my teammates the ball before I get my own shot. If they are scoring, it is easier for me to score. I try to get them the ball as much as possible," Babos said.
