Health, Human Srv. Provides \$3 Million

WASHINGTON, DC — The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) is providing \$3.1 million to the New Jersey Family Planning League (NJFPL) in Newark, which works with local providers to bring low-income patients health care services.

"While women's health services have been severely cut at the state level, this federal funding will help women in New Jersey gain access to affordable health care in their communities," said Senator Frank Lautenberg (D-N.J.), a member of the Senate Appropriations Committee, which funds HHS. "Women's health services are under attack by political extremists and it's more important than ever that we keep fighting to ensure quality care is available to every woman."

"This funding is critically important to providing quality, affordable health services to women across New Jersey, regardless of income," said Senator Bob Menendez (D-N.J.). "Ensuring comprehensive health services are available for women means healthier families and healthier communities, and that's why I will always fight for the resources to support our local health care facilities."

This funding brings the NJFPL's total federal funding this year to \$6.3 million. The NJFPL works with Planned Parenthood of Metropolitan New Jersey, Planned Parenthood of Central and Greater Northern New Jersey, Hoboken Family Planning, and Women's Health and Counseling Center in Somerville to fund 25 clinic sites that provide health services to low-income families across the state.

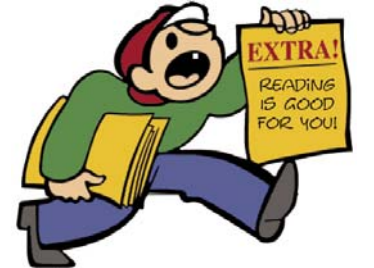
Mountainside Asked to Make Repairs Following Damage to Property

MOUNTAINSIDE — The Borough Council gathered for about an hour Tuesday night for the first of its bi-monthly general meetings. Business consisted chiefly of several unanimous resolutions and bid approvals, and an issue raised by a citizen concerning damage allegedly done to his walkway during borough maintenance.

Longtime residents Richard and Kathleen Ruggeri of Orchard Road, whose property suffered some damage in 2005 when a borough-contracted company replaced the curb along their street. In the process, some of their personal walkway was ripped up, and after a multi-month process to get the walkway repaired the work was deemed shoddy by an outside

source. The repaired section has deteriorated and now the Ruggeris hope to engage the municipality in further repairs. Due to statutes of limitations regarding how much time can go by before citizens file a complaint with the town over damage caused by public works, the issue was left open-ended as town administrators check the official dates of the matter.

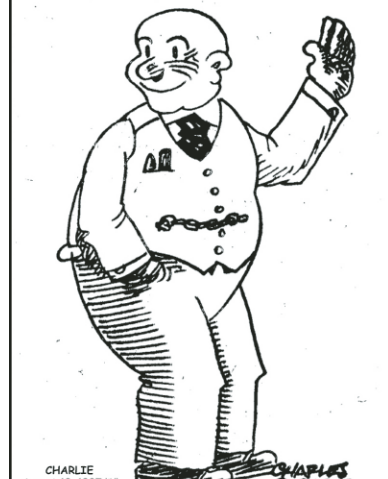
