The game ended on an unassisted double play by first baseman Pindilli, who snagged a line drive and stepped on the base to ring up the runner.

Head Coach Jeff Gerris praised his team's efforts, saying, "Our pitchers are throwing strikes with the confidence that comes from knowing your fielders are consistently making the routine plays. And our bats are alive."

**Walk Down Memory Lane**

**July 12, 2008:** The value of the "walk" played a starring role in the Scotch Plains-Fanwood Gold 9-year-old baseball team's 11-1 victory over Westfield White in the semifinal round of the Cal Ripken District 12 Tournament at Booth Field in Scotch Plains. The Gold's Peter Warren ripped a two-run single. Jake Longo and Kyle Kelly singled and had a pair of RBI. Sean Valli (RBI) and Ryan Peterson each singled and scored twice. Jimmy Harcourt had an RBI single, walked twice and scored once. Matt Lettieri singled, was hit by a pitch and scored once. Kyra Lockhart had an RBI single.

**July 12, 2007:** KMD Tuning of Mountainside brought an undermanned contingent to Memorial Field in Westfield and a vicious American Legion battalion took advantage of the shortage with an 18-3 ambush in Union County Senior 50+ Softball League action. Tom Straniero (4-for-4, 4 runs scored) keyed in on the sun glared right field vulnerability and whacked three one-run singles and a triple. Tony Williams (2 runs scored)

cracked all three of his hits, which included a two-run triple and an RBI single, mercifully to leftfield.

**July 13, 2006:** Key run-preventing fielding plays and a productive four-run first inning paved the way for the Westfield 11-year-old baseball team to top Long Hill, 5-2, in North Jersey League action at Gumbert Field. Kevin Mikovits had two hits, one a two-run single in the first inning. Brett Glen ripped an RBI double and walked and Charlie Cullinan singled and scored.

**July 12, 2005:** CJ Meyer smacked a two-run home run in the bottom of the first inning to spark an early Westfield Blue uprising that led to an 8-6 victory over Scotch Plains-Fanwood and to force a second and final game for the title in the Cal Ripken District 12 double elimination baseball tournament at Gumbert Field.

**July 9, 2000:** The JCC Marauders lifted their record to 4-3 by dominating the Old Stars, 25-7, at Tamaques Park. Neil Leitner launched two homers and Adam Shaeffer slammed a grand slam. Jim Polonski, Dave Hyden, Marshall Feldman and Tom Lopez also homered.
