

N.J., Sussex Top Transparency Websites

ALEXANDRIA, VA - Sunshine Review, a national nonprofit organization dedicated to government transparency, released the winners of the third annual Sunny Awards.

6,000 government websites and graded each on a 10-point transparency checklist. The editors looked at content available on government websites against what should be provided.

The award, which honors the most transparent government websites in the nation, went to 214 government entities including two in New Jersey: the New Jersey state website and the website for Sussex County.

The winners of the Sunny Award all received an "A" grade during the extensive grading process.

New Rule Allows Flexibility On Some DEP Regulations

TRENTON - In response to a Governor Chris Christie executive order directing state agencies to implement "common sense" principles of government reform, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has adopted a new rule that gives the DEP flexibility to modify compliance with rules in certain limited circumstances that do not compromise protections for the environment or public health.

DEP Proposes Amendments to Enhance Public Access to N.J. Beaches, Waterways

TRENTON - After considering public comments, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) on Monday formally proposed amended rules to improve and enhance public access to New Jersey's beaches, bays and waterways, DEP Commissioner Bob Martin announced.
