followed with an RBI single to left.

From his shortstop position, Delle Donne also played the starring role in the exciting finale. After Vickie's Pat Peterpaul poked a single to left, Carlos Rego ripped a wicked shot off pitcher Ed Belford's glove, but Delle Donne scooped the deflection, stepped on second and fired to first to complete a double play (DP). Then Brandon Cuba tagged a line shot that Delle Donne absorbed for the game ender.

Both teams amassed 25 hits and Richichi contributed four, including his double, with three RBI and two runs scored. Delle Donne finished with three hits, two RBI and three runs scored. Dom Centanni cracked a pair of two-run doubles and added an RBI sacrifice fly, while scoring twice. John Lyp lashed three singles, scored three times and had two RBI. Kyle Adams singled twice and scored three times.

Vickie's had three players with four hits — Al Genova (3 runs scored, RBI), Al Dente (3 RBI, 2 runs scored) and Rich Banasiak (3 RBI, run scored, 2 walks). Jason Hoynowski (3 runs) singled, walked twice and hammered a key two-run homer in the ninth inning. Alberto Cortez smacked a solo homer in the sixth. Cuba finished with three hits and two runs scored, and Mookie Fronzak singled twice

and scored twice.

Two of the finest fielding plays came in the first inning. Fronzak chased down a long shot to leftfield off the bat of Delle Donne in the top of the first then Adams cradled Jason Hoynowski's shot in right field near the basketball court.

For the first four innings, Autoland was either spinning their wheels or idling as not one tread scarred home plate. During that span, second baseman Dente initiated a second-to-first DP. But Delle Donne had also initiated a DP in the second inning. Vickie's plated the first five runs in the third, highlighted by Dente's two-run double into shallow right, Banasiak's RBI slap shot to right and Matt Hoynowski's RBI sac fly to center. Autoland centerfielder Brian Schiller probably made the best catch of the evening with a chest sliding snag of John Gordon's low liner.

Vickie's cooked up three more runs in the fourth to grab an 8-0 lead. Gordon wiggled an RBI single over second, Genova added an RBI groundout and Dente dribbled an RBI single by third.

Autoland finally revved their engines in the fifth and screeched with six runs. During that time, Centanni rapped a two-run double, Lorenz

looped an RBI double, Josh Finkelstein yanked a two-run single and Richichi plopped an RBI single over first.

Autoland was racing with high octane and poured on seven more runs in the sixth to take a 13-8 lead. Centanni added his second two-run double, while Billy Mariani, Lyp and Delle Donne tacked on RBI singles. Vickie's responded with Cortez's solo blast to right-centerfield.

In the seventh, Autoland boosted their lead to 17-9 with four runs on five hits. Richichi lined a two-run single to right, Lyp punched an RBI single to left and Centanni lofted an RBI sac fly to center.

Autoland began to run out of gas in the eighth, but Vickie's came up with a recipe for runs on three straight singles from Jason Hoynowski, Genova and Dente, respectively, an RBI single from Banasiak and a two-run triple from Matt Hoynowski to eventually place five runs on the dish.

With Autoland still silent, Vickie's responded with three runs in the ninth thanks to Jason Hoynowski's two-run shot with Fronzak on base, and Banasiak's chopping single that scored Genova with the tying run, setting up the dramatic finale.
