

WF Youth Wrestlers Win Big in Raritan Valley League

Westfield's Raritan Valley League wrestling team, league champions in 2012-13, remained perfect in its 2013-14 campaign, defeating Somerville, 52-24, and Watchung Hills, 41-33, on January 11 at Scotch Plains to go 4-0 on the season.

Against Somerville, Westfield won five of the first six matches, and 11 of 17 overall. Shane Hanna recorded a pin at 80-lbs. Quinn Gimblette and Jackson Jordan also recorded pins at 67- and 70-lbs pound, respectively.

Westfield then faced Watchung Hills and the outcome uncertain until the very end. Westfield won nine bouts and Watchung Hills won eight.

"In then end, we knew it would come down to bonus points," said coach Michael Price. "This is something we teach our boys: to maximize our team score, and minimize our opponent's score by never quitting. The boys responded in big way today."

Jake Holtzman secured a take down with two seconds remaining to score a major decision, and Andrew Cherry fending off a side headlock for an 11-10 win at 85 pounds secured the victory for Westfield.

"Andrew fought off his back for nearly 20 seconds, while his opponent squeezed that headlock tight," added coach Chris Jordan. "If he lets up there and gets pinned, that would be a nine-point swing and we lose the match 39-38. He showed a lot of guts and determination."

Ethan Composto, Cole Turnoff, Jackson Jordan and Jeremy Heyder all won by pin.

Westfield's two other victories were against Scotch Plains (73-9) on December 7 and Ridge (68-12) on December 21.

Westfield Matmen Notch Six Wins in Cent. Jersey League

Westfield's Central Jersey League wrestling team's season swung into high gear during the past week, competing in six dual meets in as many days, and winning all by decisive margins.

The biggest victory came on January 10 when the Westfield matmen snapped South Plainfield's 63-match winning streak, spanning five seasons, with a 50-22 victory. The match was hosted at Edison Intermediate School gymnasium in front of an excited home crowd. Westfield captured victories at 11 of 17 weight classes, including five consecutive victories in the middle of the lineup that swung the momentum heavily in the home team's favor.

"South Plainfield has a rich wrestling tradition," said Coach Colin Mackay. "This victory is a measuring stick for our program as we strive for continuous improvement."

"The crowd made a big difference

for us tonight," added Coach Al Rabinowitz. "Our boys were enthusiastic to see so many of their friends in the stands, many who were attending their first dual meet. It was a lot of fun."

Westfield notched a second victory on Friday evening, topping a gritty Franklin team, 45-34. The team's other victories this past week were: Roselle Park (67-15) on January 6; and Clark (74-15), Flemington (65-14) and Hillsborough (81-6) on January 11.

The team is now 7-0 in Central Jersey League action. The team next competes this Saturday, January 18, when they host Rahway and Watchung Hills at Westfield High School's back gym at 12 p.m.

"Watchung Hills is one of the top teams we will face this season," added Coach Darren Composto. "It is going to be a war, but we are looking forward to it."
