Roth, who also won the UCT third singles title last year, advanced to the NJSIAA singles round of 32 and finished with a 21-7 record.

Freshman Noah Reich demonstrated his ability at second singles and came out on top with a UCT crown and eventually finished with an 18-9 record.

"Noah didn't play Summit the first

time we played, so we didn't know how he was going to match up with their second singles player. He got to the finals and beat him, 6-0, 6-0. He blew the kid away. It was awesome to watch if you were a Westfield fan," Coach Kapner said.

Freshman Owen Bartok competed at third singles, placed third in the UCT and finished 17-11.

With only one slot to be filled next year, Coach Kapner said, "There's a number of players ready to be that seventh player and who are working hard to get there. I am excited about the future."

One thing that Coach Kapner al-

ways does not seem to look forward to is the inter-team competition.

"I don't enjoy the month of March. We have challenge matches. The kids are going after each other. It's kids on my team against kids on my team. There were nights that I didn't get home until after dark. Challenge matches were going three sets, and 7-5 and 7-6. There was one that was a 10-8 tiebreaker in the third set, because they were so evenly matched. The thing that I love is, as soon as the lineup is set, you see it go away. They care about each other so much. This has been part of our culture for quite awhile," he said.

or run scored.

In her four-year WHS career, Chambliss was first all-time with 129 runs scored, first all-time in doubles with 27, tied for first with 11 doubles in a season, career triples with 16 and nine in a season, second in hits with 147, second in runs scored in a season with 41, third all-time in RBI with 81 and tied for fifth place all-time for most RBI in a season with 34.

This season, senior Chrissy Ferraro led the team with a .505 BA, hits with 46, home runs with two and runs scored with 36. She added 13 RBI, 13 stolen bases and had an on base percentage of .521. As a centerfielder, she had 25 putouts and four assists.

Ferraro had a career total of 120 hits, a .436 BA, 102 runs scored, 36 stolen bases and 103 putouts in the outfield. She was third all-time with 102 career runs and third with 46 hits in a season, fourth all-time in career hits with 120, fifth all-time with 36 runs in a season and tied for sixth with highest BA in a season at .505.

Senior Shannon Schaefer recorded a .321 BA with 25 hits, seven doubles and one triple. She led the team with 13 walks. On the mound, Schaefer had a 3-0 record with 35 strikeouts in 31 innings pitched.

In her four-years, Schaefer had 104 hits, 16 doubles, seven triples and 11

homeruns. On the mound, she had a 17-13 overall record with 166 strikeouts. She was second all-time with eight home runs in a season (2012), fourth in career RBI with 78, fourth with 43 hits in a season, fifth with 80 career runs scored and sixth with highest season BA of .500 (2012).

Senior catcher/first baseman Lizzie Fox recorded a .259 BA this season with 14 runs scored, 10 RBI and 15 hits, including two doubles. Fox recorded 152 putouts with only two errors - 70 more touches than anyone else on the team. She had a career total 388 putouts with only seven errors in four seasons.

Senior outfielder/first baseman Becca Kaufman ended the season with a .302 BA with 19 hits, including one triple, 10 RBI, 16 runs scored and 13 free passes. Defensively, she had two assists and 26 putouts. Kaufman had a .290 career BA with 34 hits, including a triple and four doubles, 16 RBI and 24 runs scored.

Junior Sam Velez, a two-year letter winner, exercised her versatility, playing multiple positions, and showed her moxie on the base paths. This season, she had a .338 BA with 25 hits, including a double, 16 RBI and 19 runs scored. As a catcher, outfielder and third baseman, Velez recorded 10 assists and 41 putouts.

Junior two-year letter winner Bobbi Snyder had a .340 BA with 17 hits, including two doubles, nine RBI and 14 runs scored.

Sophomore Elena Elliott, who played in all 25 games, finished with a .271 BA, 16 hits, including two doubles, eight RBI and 15 runs scored. Defensively, she had six assists and 16 putouts. In 15 innings pitched, Elliott recorded 10 strikeouts and had a 3-0 record.

Freshman Danielle Rinaldi played in 20 games and had 17 assists and 22 putouts.

"This team as a whole had a great year. Every single player contributed to the success of the season. Some of the best moments of our season include winning another county title, beating North Hunterdon for the first time in many years and going on an 11-game winning streak after our loss against Johnson. This team competed and performed," Coach MacDonald said.

A lot of new faces will be seen on the field next year, but, "The four players who we have returning next season are so fortunate to have had the opportunity to be on a team with so much experience. We'll be looking to them to use that next season to provide leadership for what will be a very inexperienced team," Coach MacDonald said.
